Dear parents/carers,

Forest School – Year 1

Children in Year 1 will be attending Forest School starting Tuesday 7th January 2025, the last session will be Tuesday 11th February 2025.

Your child will be taking part in the **morning session** so will need to wear their Forest School 'kit' every Tuesday to school and bring their full uniform to change into.

As Forest School runs throughout the year, come rain or shine, it is important that parents send their children into school dressed appropriately (or in a bag if they are participating in the pm session)

The only time Forest School may be cancelled due to inclement weather is high winds, sessions will still run even if it is raining heavily (with appropriate adaptations made by Forest School Leaders).

As the weather gets cooler during the Autumn and Winter months, children will need to wear/bring lots of layers, the more the better.

A suggested kit list is as follows:

- Jogging bottoms/ comfortable trousers
- A long sleeved T-shirt (or two if it's super cold) with a jumper or sweatshirt on top
- Boots which are ideally waterproof walking boots (may need respraying with water proof spray from time to time) as these are better at insulating the feet when it's really cold but if not lots of socks and wellies will be fine.
- Two pairs of socks
- Waterproof trousers and a waterproof coat with a hood.
- Gloves and hats
- Thermal base layers (optional if your child gets cold quickly).
